



STUDY FINDS RIDGE PROJECT PROGRAMS HAVE SIGNIFICANT RESULTS



- 2.3 million abults in Prison, 800,000 on Parole
- 7.5 million children with a parent in corrections
 These children are now at-risk of Recoming the pext.
- These children are now at-risk of Becoming the next generation of offenders
- 21,950 Fathers incarcerated in Ohio with an average of 3 chlbren each
- High recipivism rates


Families And Inmates Together In Harmony

- * These impacts appear to be both in terms of skulls learned and behavioral changes that are taking place in the relationships and families that are a part of the program.
