Births to unmarried mothers:

- State of Georgia: 39% of all births (2004 Georgia vital Statistics).
- Metro-Atlanta all ages: 35%.
- Under 25 years: 65%
- Columbus [Georgia]: 45% of all ages
- Under 25 years: 84% (Georgia Campaign for Adolescent Pregnancy Prevention (G-CAAP) “Fast facts” www.gcaap.org)

FRAME-Works Demographics

- 11 Metro-Atlanta counties and Muscogee County, Georgia
- Age Clients 20-25 years (45% of clients)
- Race: 88% African American; 3% Hispanic; 2 % Caucasian

Note: Georgia’s percentage of children born to unmarried mothers is usually a few percentages higher than the national average.
