



Playdough Charades

Step-by-Step Instructions:

1. Start by dividing the class into two teams.
2. Have teams sit across from each other and face each other. It works well if there is a small table between them.
3. Decide which team will go first.
4. One member of the first team should take a paper strip from the basket.
5. That member must then use the modeling clay to sculpt the item listed on the paper.
6. Including sculpting time, give the team 2 or 3 minutes to figure out what the object is.
7. If the group figures out what the object is they score a point.
8. If the group does not figure out the object, the other team gets a turn to guess. If they guess correctly, they get a point.
9. Whether team two gets a point or not, the next turn is theirs.
10. Continue back and forth until either team reaches 5 points.

Tips for Discussion and Processing

This is a fun icebreaker activity to get the class warmed up and having fun.

Group Size: 10 - 20

Time Needed: 15 to 20 minutes

Goal: To build group cohesion

Audience: Parents, Couples, Families, Teens, Children, Singles

Special Considerations: Can be a little messy

Resources Needed:

- ✓ At least one set of modeling clay per team, modeling clay tools, strips of paper with the name of an object already written on them (like apple, dog, airplane, etc.), basket for paper strips
